



## Guidelines for working with Pharmaceutical Companies

1. In an arms-length relationship with pharmaceutical companies, CLL Canada will provide patient perspectives while protecting individual patient privacy.
2. CLL Canada accepts pharmaceutical funding for support of CLL Canada activities. Pharmaceutical companies do not have any control of content or provide direction to these activities. This means we will not:
  - i. Distribute branded information on behalf of one company;
  - ii. Provide personal information about our members to drug companies;
  - iii. Endorse any product or brand.
3. Requests from pharmaceutical companies will flow through the Chair, with actions requiring Board approval.
4. Board members will **not** accept personal gifts from pharmaceutical companies. Board members will declare any perceived conflicts of interest with pharmaceutical companies.
